Our mission is to help homeless men who are motivated to live sober, responsible lives. We do this by providing low-cost sober housing. This means that they must pass urine tests, stay up-to-date with their prescriptions, and attend at least one weekly "self-help group" (AA, NA, Chaplain Tim Lanigan, etc.). We also help them become responsible by helping them get a job or sign-up for and begin collecting disability benefits, work to keep them current with their program fees, help them obtain a driver's license or non-driver's ID, help them obtain suitable transportation, and helping them develop and pursue life goals.

Our vision is to transform homeless men into godly men, mature in their faith, giving back to their community. We do this by encouraging each client to attend at least one weekly Christian meeting (Church service, Bible study, prayer), rebuild relationships, and be actively discipled by a mature male believer.



Who are we wanting to reach?

Homeless men who are *motivated* to live sober lives, to grow as a person, and to turn their lives around.



Where are those people located?

- 85% greater Manchester area
- · 12% from the rest of NH
- 3% come from outside of NH



Why do they need our help?

They need help taking the positive steps necessary to develop sober, productive, and responsible lives.



How are we going to reach them?

By providing low-cost sober housing that offers Christian life coaching and case management



Our Sober Housing Goals

50% of our clients achieve these sobriety measures for at least three months.

- Drug Screening.
 - o 100% pass urine tests 100% of the time.
- Prescription Drugs.
 - o 75% of the above stay up-to-date with prescriptions 80% of the time.
- Self-Help.
 - 75% of the above voluntarily attend at least one weekly "self-help group" 80% of the time.



Our Responsibility Goals

Of those who stay in the program for at least three months:

- Keep a job or collect disability.
 - o 100% . . . 100% of the time.
- Program Fees Paid.
 - 100% within two weeks of the time.
- Driver's License/ID.
 - o 100%.
- Safe & Reliable Transportation.
 - o 100%.



Our Vision Goals

Of those who stay in the program for at least three months:

- Discussions on How to Restore Relationships.
 - o 100%.
- Attend Semi-weekly Life-Skills Meeting.
 - 0 70%.
- Attend Weekly Christian Meeting.
 - o 25% . . . 80% of the time.
- Actively Being Discipled By a Mature Believer.
 - o 15%.
